About the Course

OBJECTIVE

The Rail Container Logistics Management Program is an intensive Three-day course developed by The Chartered Institute of Logistics and Transport, India (CILT-INDIA).

The program designed is to provide detailed exposure of activities related to Rail Container Logistics Management by the team of Logistics experts via video-conferencing mode.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

The Certificate course is targeted for working executives on "Rail Container Logistics Management" and related services. It is also recommended for field level staff and executives working in multi-modal logistics companies (specifically CTOs) and others making a career change into any of above industry segments.

PROGRAM OUTLINE

There will be a total of 4 sessions over two days and Day 3 session will be dedicated to answering questions and filling up the gaps in understanding.

The programme will be conducted and directed by CILT India and team of Logistics experts led by Shri Amitabha Chaudhuri IRTS Rtd, CMILT, & MD of IndiaLinx.

Shri Aseem Dar, Sr. GM Operations will conduct the sessions on both days.

SESSION PLAN FOR THE TRAINING

The programme will cover the following contents in five sessions during three days

SESSION I

- **Origins of PCTO Industry**
- **Salient features of MCA** : Basics of IRH, Hub and Spoke, Restricted commodities, RC-5, Various Railway charges

SESSION II

- **How the PCTO industry has evolved since 2007**: Advantage CONCOR. Level playing field a myth? About PCTOs - overcrowding, asset build up, acquisitions, asset dilutions, collaborations

SESSION III

Core Operations

- **Railways**: Container Rake: structure/design, types; Norms/Rly charges: stabling, shunting, loco detentions, siding charges; IR org structure: Station-Division-Zone, Hierarchy of officials; Other Operational concepts: Rationalised Routes, RR, E-RR, placements, withdrawals, loco requisitions.
- **Customs**: Exim containers, carrier bonds, LCs
- **Domestic movements** : Pvt sidings, CRTs, CRT charges, DSO containers/cabotage
- **Terminals**: ICDs/PFTs, Gateway Ports, Domestic Terminals

SESSION IV

- **A day in the life of an Ops exec of a PCTO** : Pendency (SMTPs and Forwarding Notes), cargo projections, Train running positions and en-route monitoring (FOIS), Train Planning with cargo projections, Advance inward unloading memos to terminals, Load Plans to terminals, Priority placements of trains, Inbound survey, Train handling, Outbound survey, Loco requisition memo as per the guidelines of MCA, Train withdrawals, Outward train summary to destinations/ports, Liaison with the IR
- **Challenges** : Cargo imbalance, U/F runs, rake repositions, Short term/Long term deployment of idle capacity, Priority evacuations vs FIFO evacuations (SSR charges to ports), Vessel connections-handover to vessel cut offs (via charges)
- **Profitability Drivers** : Fill factor- U/F runs, TAT-Concept of Round Trips-No of loadings/month, asset sweating, Laden to MTY ratio, Flexibility in operations, Terminal networking, collaborations between CTOs/Terminals, Cost control vs Cost reduction.

- Answering Questions And Filling Up The Gaps in Understanding
